

A short form Words & Pictures is a five-frame storyboard which helps the parent/s tells the child/ren in the immediacy what is happening, why and what the plan is. It keeps children grounded in the present.

## The structure

First of all, concentrate on the words and don't worry about the pictures yet. You will need to share the draft with the parent/s and where necessary amend:

- 1. <u>Title and positive frame</u> What is the focus of the storyboard eg 'Why Jim is living in foster care'. What would the child/ren really welcome for example hearing what mum and dad are doing to make things better for them. What is driving the parents, eg 'mum and dad love you').
- 2. <u>Who is worried</u>? 'Sally got together with Jim's mum and dad to write this story to explain to Jim why he has been living in foster care since 22/03/22.
- 3. <u>What are we worried about?</u> Re-write the danger statement in childlike language.
- 4. <u>What happened then?</u> This is where you explain what did happen to the child/ren due to the worries.
- 5. <u>What are we doing about the worries?</u> Eg 'Mum and dad have been speaking to the Social Worker to work out a plan so that you can all find a way of living together in a way that you are happy and safe. They are going to find some people who will help you and them with this'.
