Working for over a decade to expose child sexual exploitation within Rotherham, Jayne's efforts included acting as a whistle blower for a series of articles in The Times about the council's apparent attempts to cover up the abuse. The articles triggered a public inquiry by Alexis Jay, and an inspection of the council by Louise Casey. Jayne Senior was awarded an MBE in the 2016. She is the author of Broken and Betrayed: The true story of the Rotherham abuse scandal by the woman who fought to expose it.	Jayne Senior MBE
