I have enough clothes and they fit me.



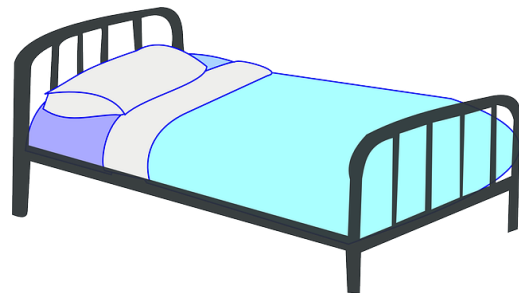
My clothes are clean.

My skin around my pad is clean.



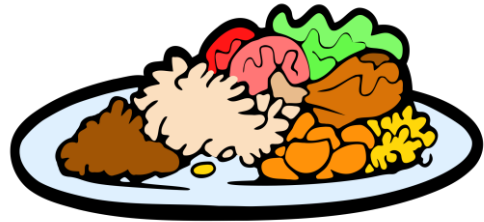

My mum/dad/carer makes me breakfast and dinner.



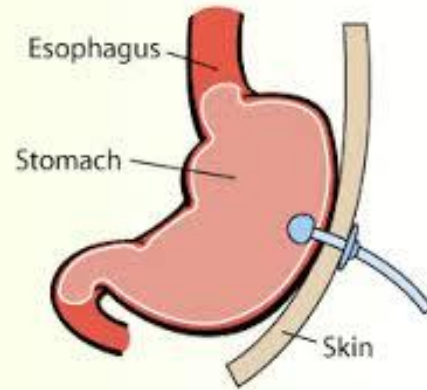
I have enough food on my plate so I am not hungry.


People I don't know come to my house.

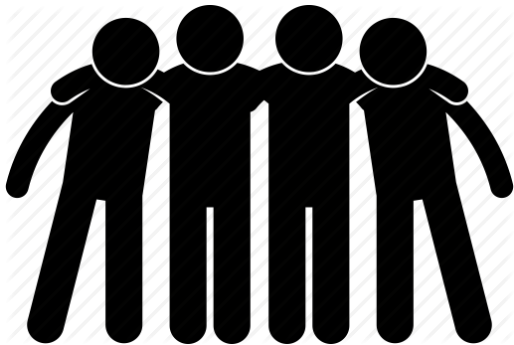

My mum/dad/carer asks who I am going out with.



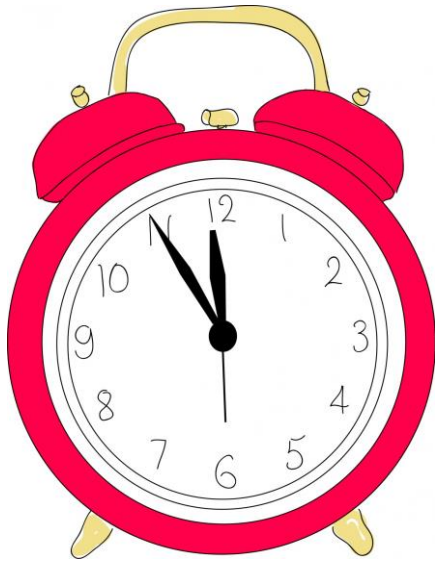
My mum/dad/carer gives me some independence.

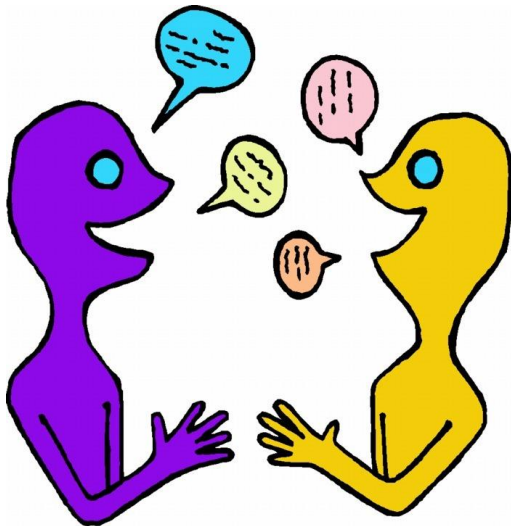
I walk to school on my own.



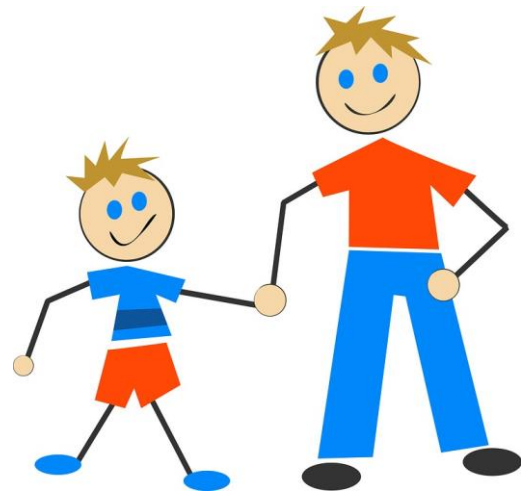
I am bullied at school.

My family are at home after school.



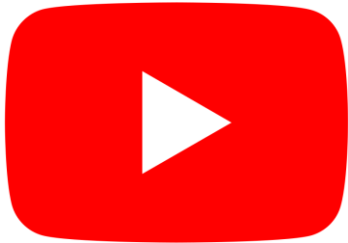
I watch TV or play on a games console.



I have help with my homework if I need it.



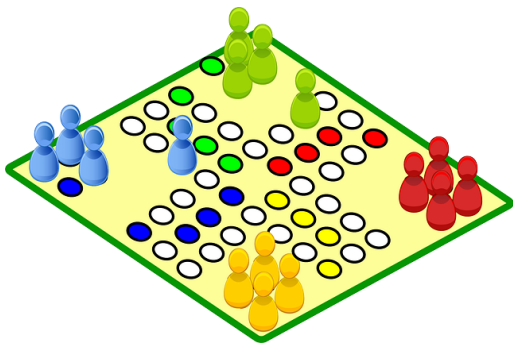
I have social media and/or watch YouTube.

I play with my mum/dad/carer/siblings after school.

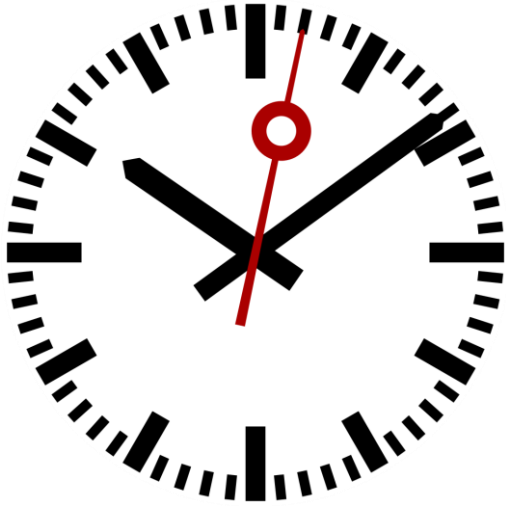


My parents/carers use my preferred communication method.

Medical

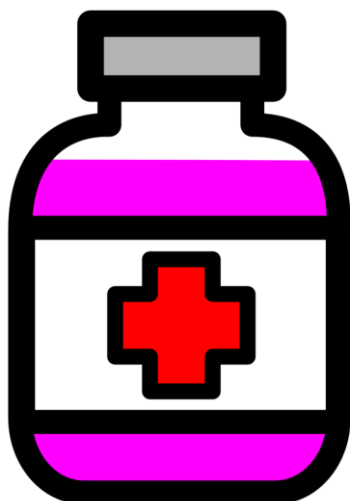
I go to the dentist.

My parents/carers take me to my appointments.

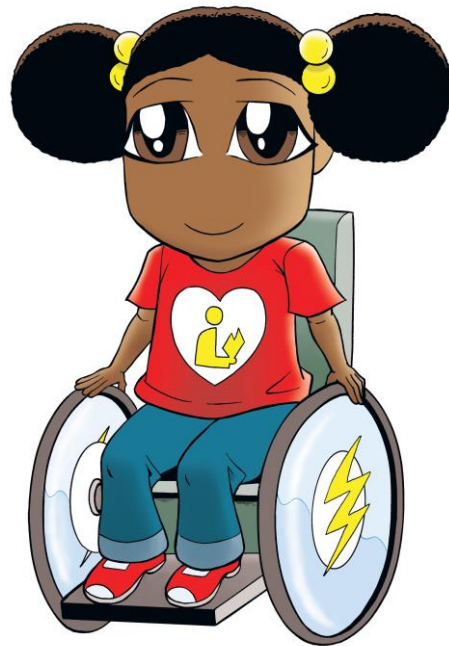


Child with a disability
